**Learn how to work with archaeological museum collections
in beautiful Silver City, New Mexico**

JOIN US for four weeks this summer from July 6 through August 1 and learn a variety of skills essential to a career in museum curation, such as cataloging with PastPerfect software, ceramic analysis, digitization, document and photograph handling, and other tasks.

You and three other students will focus on collections from the NAN Ranch, a large Classic Mimbres period pueblo in the Mimbres Valley excavated by the Texas A&M University summer archaeological field school from 1978 to 1989 and now housed at the Western New Mexico University (WNMU) Museum.
