Bandelier National Monument is filling a Tribal Engagement Program Manager position to serve five New Mexico parks and is conducting outreach to identify highly skilled and qualified candidates for the position. This notification is being circulated to inform prospective applicants of this potential upcoming opportunity and determine interest in the position, including grade-level eligibility of potential applicants.

The Position

This position will build a Tribal Engagement Program for five New Mexico parks: Bandelier National Monument, Valles Caldera National Preserve, Petroglyph National Monument, Pecos National Historical Park, and Salinas Pueblo Missions National Historical Park. The purpose of the program is to increase tribal engagement, enhance government-to-government consultation, and coordinate outreach and recruitment from within underserved tribal communities. The incumbent will work with senior park leaders to streamline engagement with the five parks' shared group of culturally affiliated Tribes to accomplish program goals. This is a full-time, permanent position, supervised by the Superintendent of Bandelier National Monument.

What we are looking for in a Candidate

The Tribal Engagement Program is new to the five parks, therefore park leaders will expect candidates who possess the qualities necessary to develop a program with no precedent, and a program that is responsive to the needs of both the tribes and the parks. The incumbent will need to possess excellent communication skills, both verbally and in writing. The incumbent is expected to use knowledge gained through lived experiences within indigenous communities to build trust and effective working relationships with Tribes and indigenous contacts. The application of knowledge of the natural and cultural resources of the US Southwest region, including a specialized understanding of the specific groups that are significant to the parks, will be necessary to perform the duties of the position.
